

## PY 2024 – By The Numbers

- **2,571** – Number of Basic Career Services Provided
- **1,399** Clients Enrolled in Programs:
  - **934** – New Client Enrollments
  - **465** – Carry-In Clients
- **94.4%** Customer Satisfaction rate
- **5** On-the-Job Training Services
- **24** Paid Work Experience Services
- **568** Occupational Training Services
- **83** Pre-Apprenticeship Services
  - **-98% increase** from PY2023
- **53** ARPA Training Stipends
- **813** Supportive Services Provided

## WIOA Performance Measures – Key Context



All performance measures: Local Area assessed annually on Pass/Fail basis



For total clients served, Local Area to reach at least 70% of enrollment goals stated in Implementation Plan.



For Core Performance Measures, average across all 5 measures must be 80% or greater once Statistical Adjustment Model is applied



Statistical Adjustment Model = Based on local economic and demographic data, establishes Pre-Program Year and Post-Program Year Estimates for each individual Core Performance Measure



Significant lag as USDOL and MDOL applies the Statistical Adjustment Model (~1 year lag)



Coastal Counties Local Area has passed WIOA Performance Measures in most recent program year data that is available (PY23)
