A. Program Fact Sheets

One page fact sheets have been developed for CCWI's 7 current grants as an overview of the grants. The sheets have been included in the packet and are also available under the "Resources" page of the CCWI website.

B. Employment Recovery Grant

This 2-year grant was awarded to CCWI from USDOL for ~\$2.3million. It focuses on reemployment services for dislocated workers who have been recently laid off and supports unemployed individuals with structured employment and training services.

C. Staffing: Two Postings Currently

CCWI has two positions that need filling:

- Business Services Liaison (full time)
- OSO Policy Associate through Cutler Institute

Both positions are having challenges finding qualified candidates due to the worker shortage.

D. Outreach Committee Work

CCWI has developed an ad-hoc Outreach Committee chaired by CCWB member Tom Nickerson. The focus will be on developing outreach strategies and a statement of work for a vendor to continue outreach work.
