A. WIOA Monitoring Response from MDOL

On July 7, 2022, CCWI received a letter from MDOL stating that all findings have been resolved and CCWI is in compliance with WIOA funding law. CCWI is the only LWB in Maine to have attained that status.

B. Grant Applications

CCWI has been hard at work applying for new funding streams. Over the past few months, applications have been submitted for 5 different grants totaling over \$3.5m. CCWI has also been assisting MDOL in applying for a \$3.2m QUEST NEG.

C. Creative Partner Community Outreach RFQ

- On May 20, 2022, CCWI broadcast an RFQ for an agency to help facilitate outreach methodologies for bringing new clients directly to Workforce Solutions.
- Due to the ability to bring in additional funding for this project, on June 27 an adjusted RFQ was broadcast that included a budget of \$35k, as well as add some clarity to the language of the RFQ
- Three responses were received by the deadline. They have been scored and the top two were asked to put on a presentation for CCWI. This is scheduled for 8/16/22.
