At its core, WIOA services seek to support participants in development, training, and job search activities required to succeed in the labor market.

Payments made for these activities, i.e. training, support services, are to be in-line with the successful completion of the participant's respective program. It is not allowable for payments to be made on <u>past debt</u>. The following policy will apply to all participants enrolled in WIOA services:

For purposes of this policy, debt will be considered money owed or due that was incurred <u>prior to the start</u> of the participant's eligibility into all WIOA based programs or for services rendered without prior approval in regards to the individual's service strategy. Any and all debt will be considered a disallowable cost and should not be paid utilizing WIOA funds.
