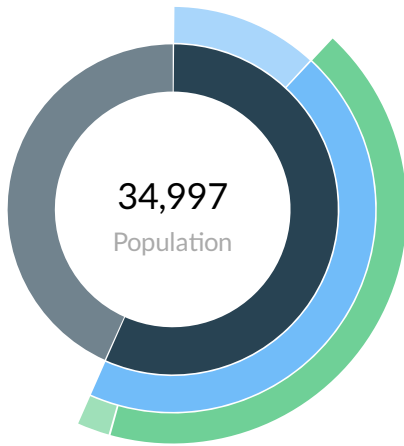
Median household income is **\$5.1K below** the national median household income of \$62.8K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 3.6%** since 2015, growing by 1,213. Population is expected to **increase by 3.9%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 1,350.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 5.2%** in Lincoln County, ME from 14,390 to **13,635**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 6.5%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 55.4% to 52.2% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.0% of Lincoln County, ME residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.0% below the national average), and **7.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Grocery Stores.

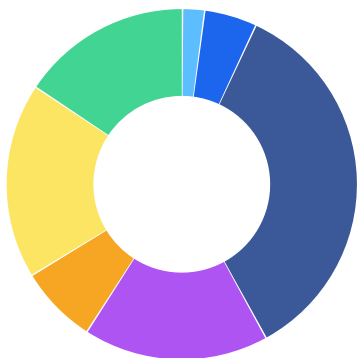

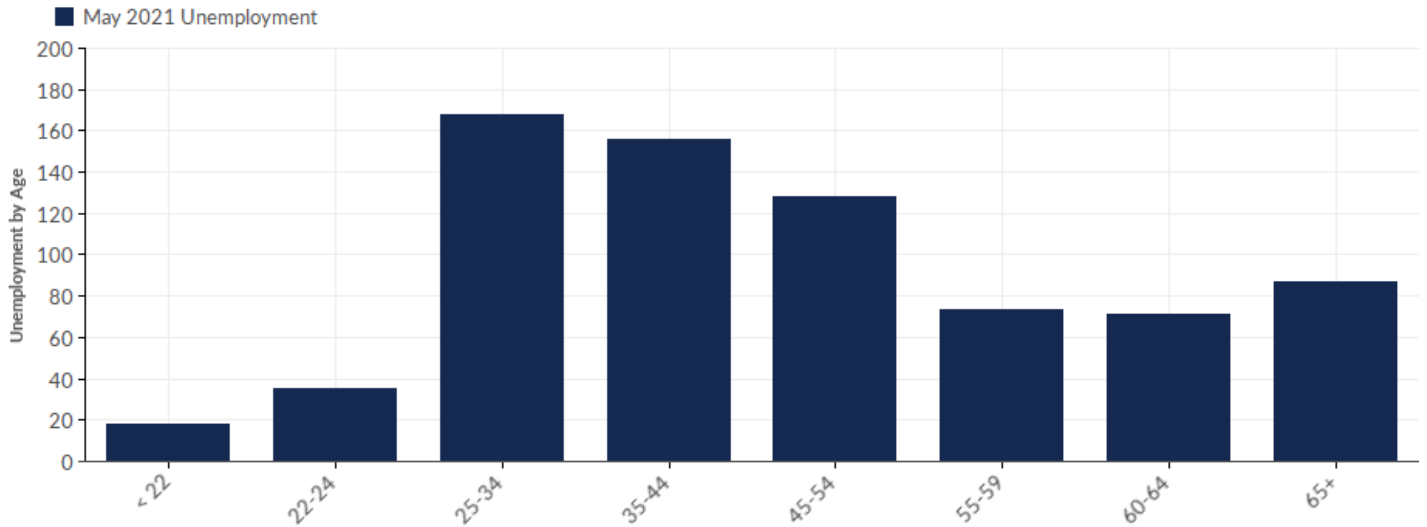

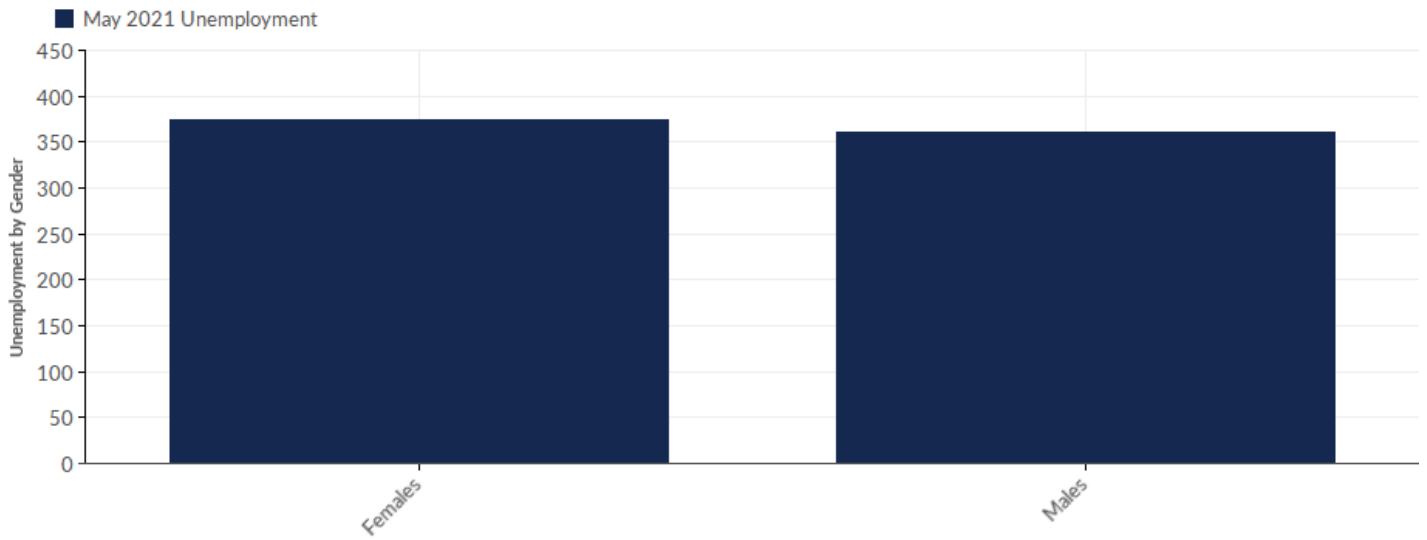

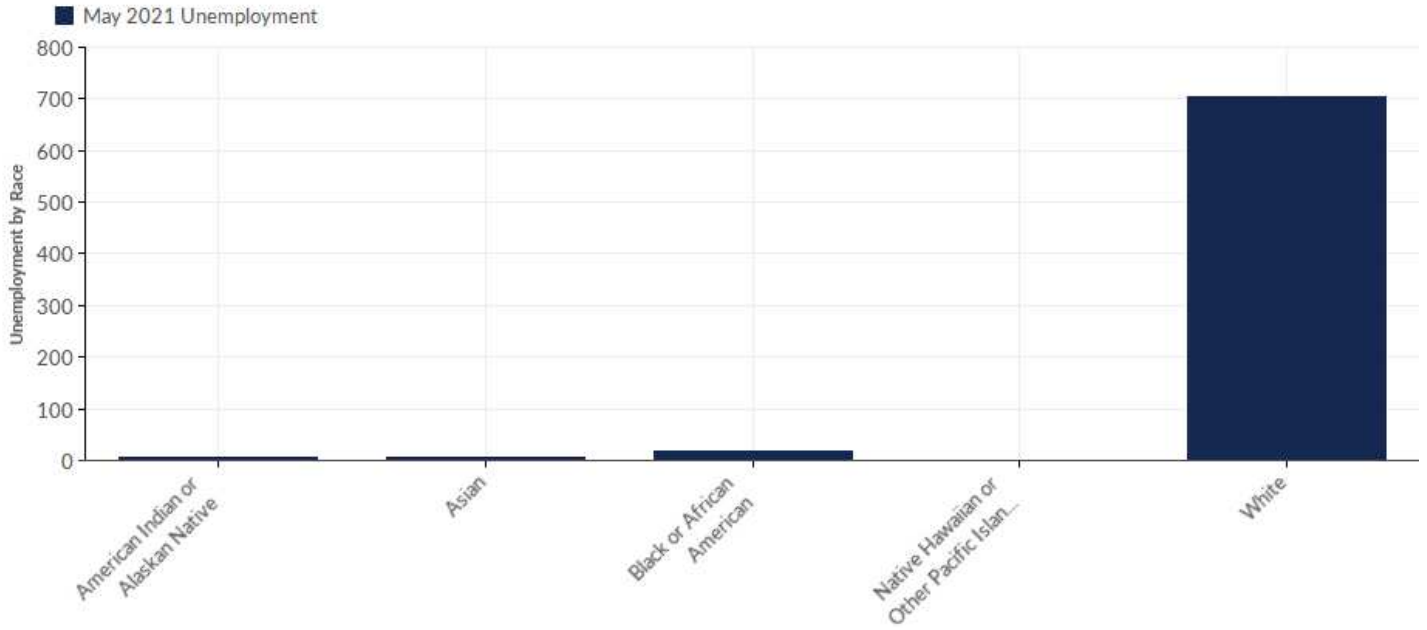

Unemployment by Gender



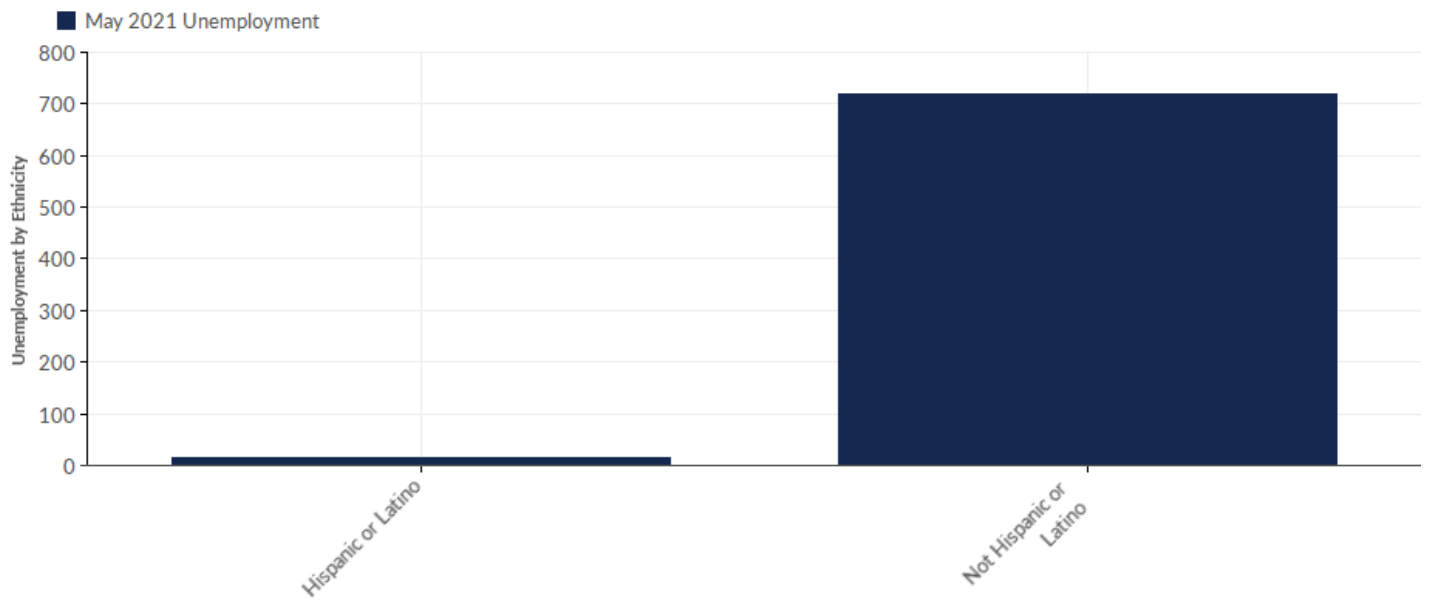

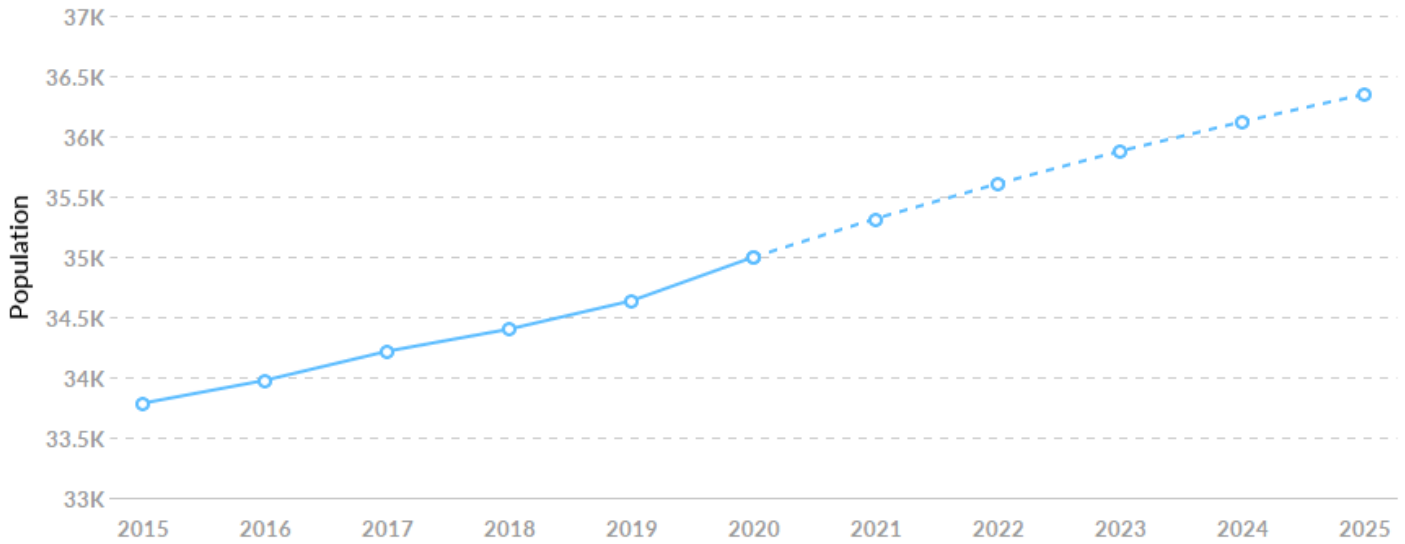

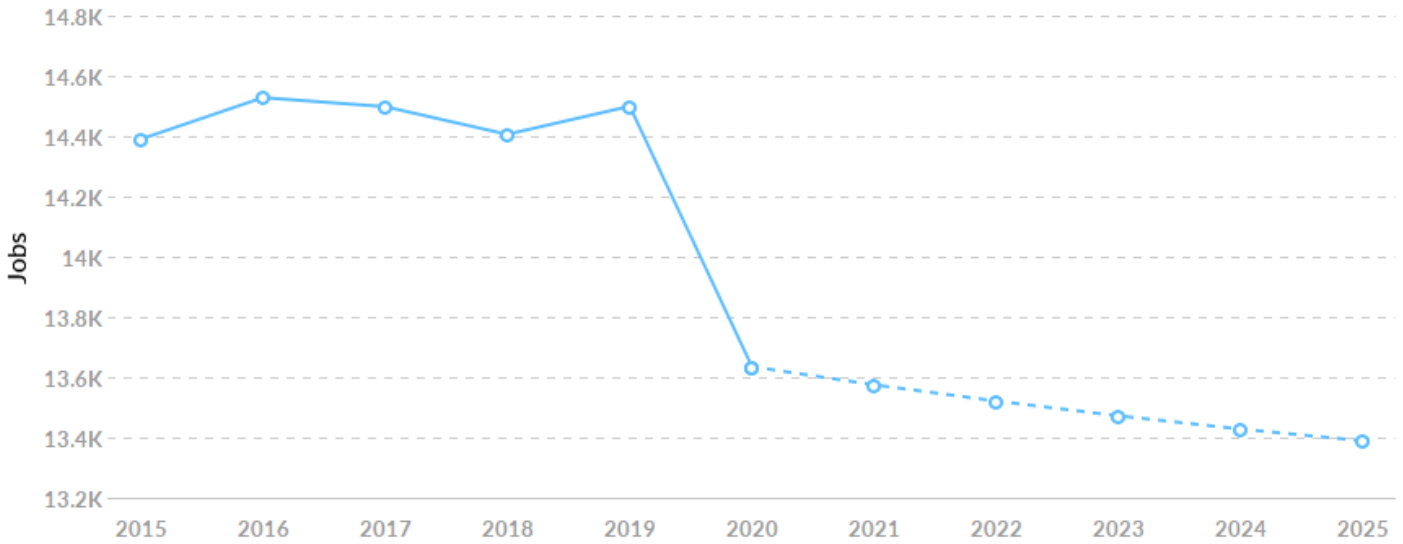

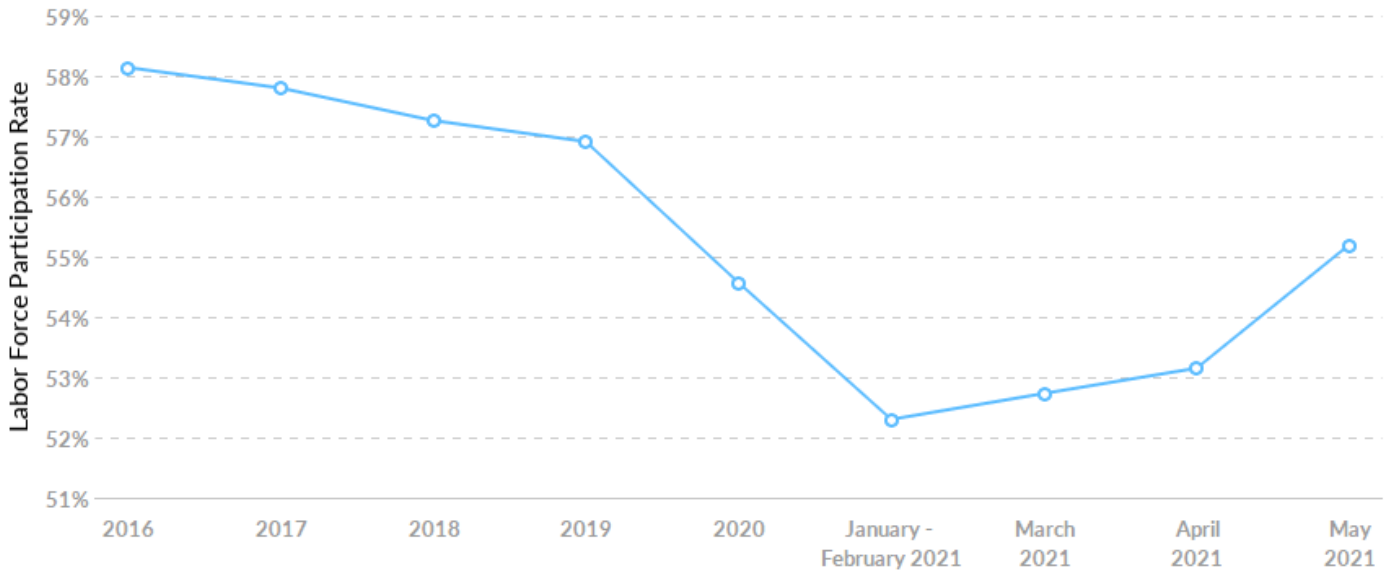
Job Trends

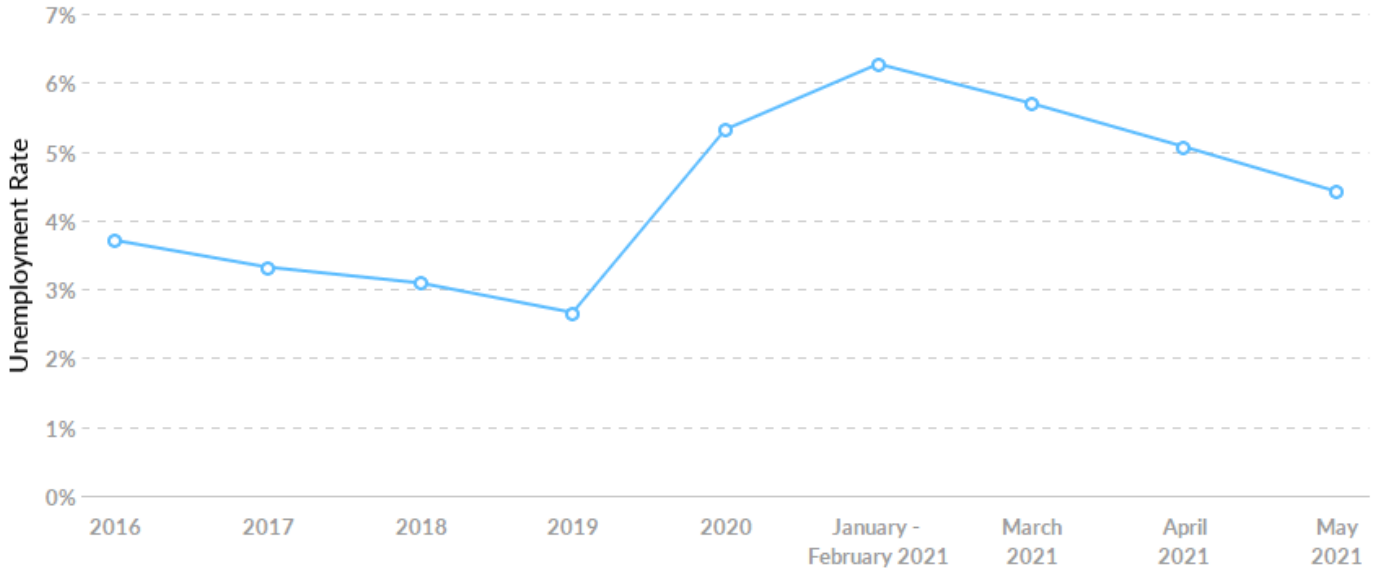

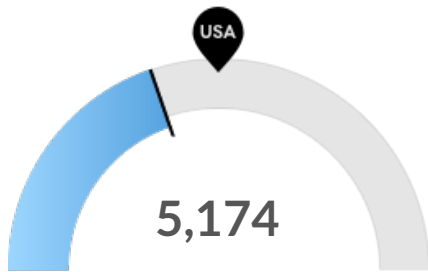
Unemployment Rate Trends

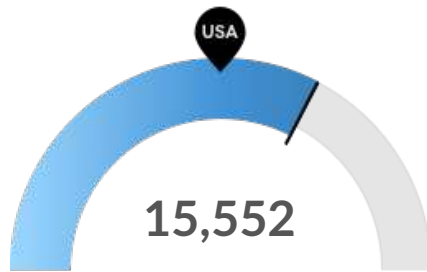

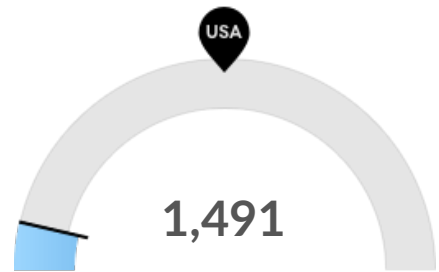
Lincoln County, ME has 5,174 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 7,141.

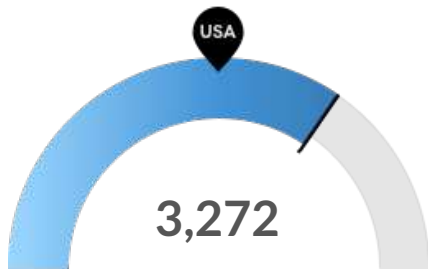
Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 10,183 people 55 or older, while there are 15,552 here.

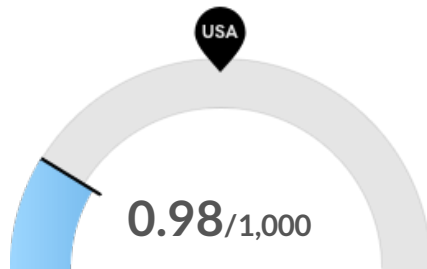
Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 13,815 racially diverse people, while there are 1,491 here.

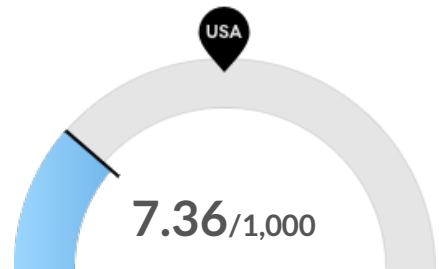

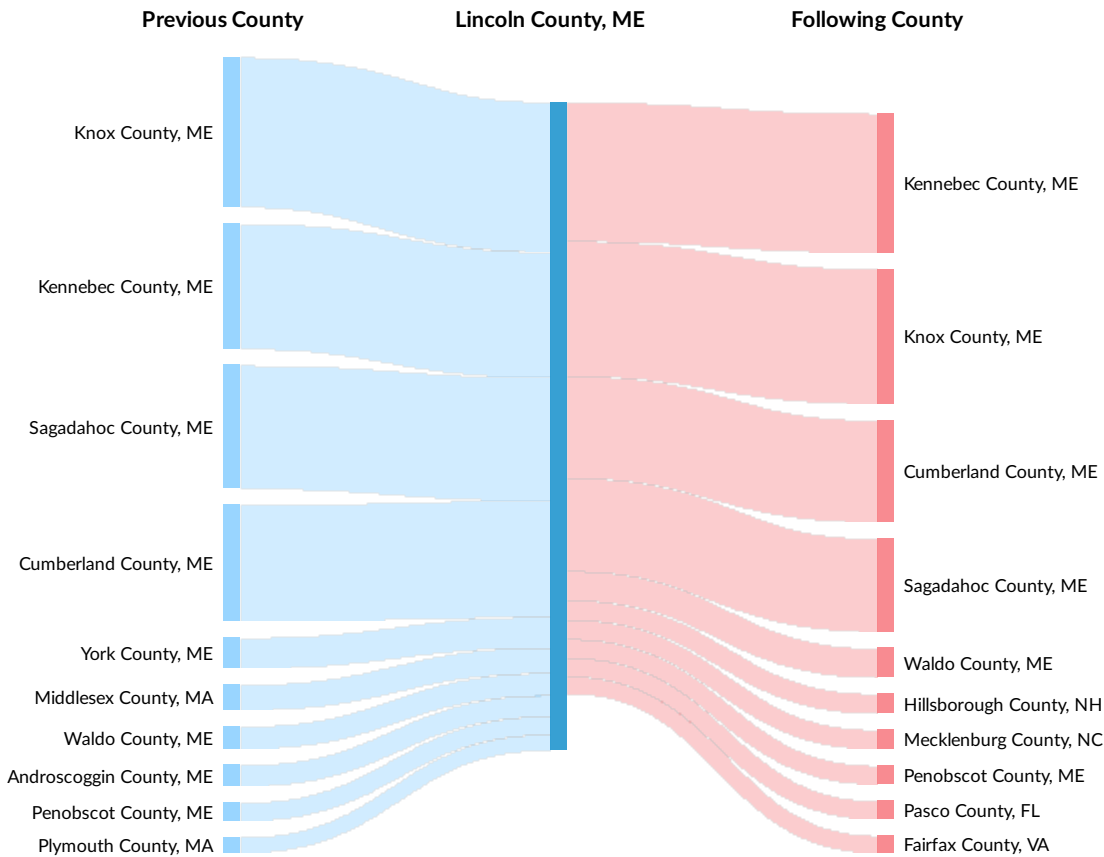

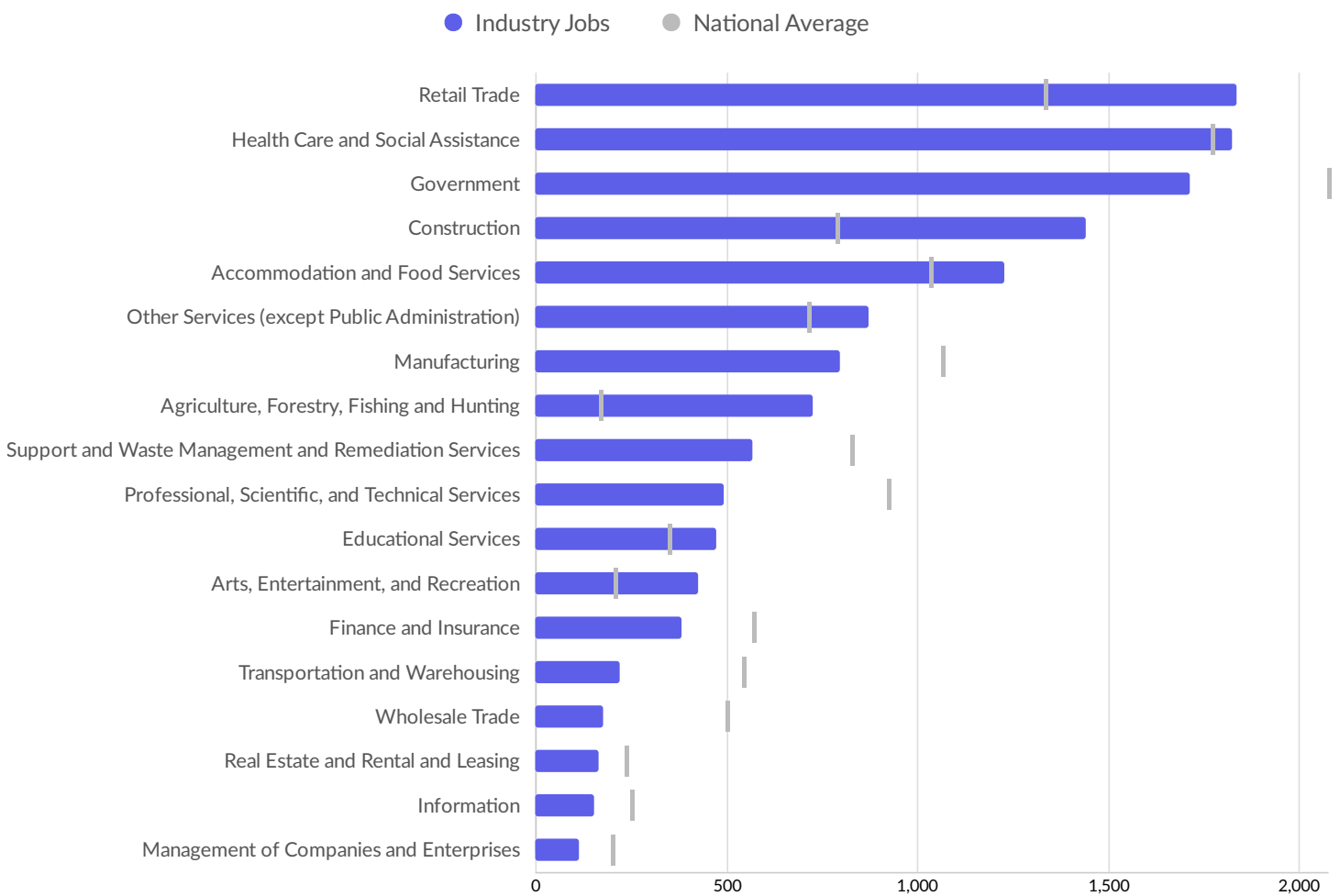

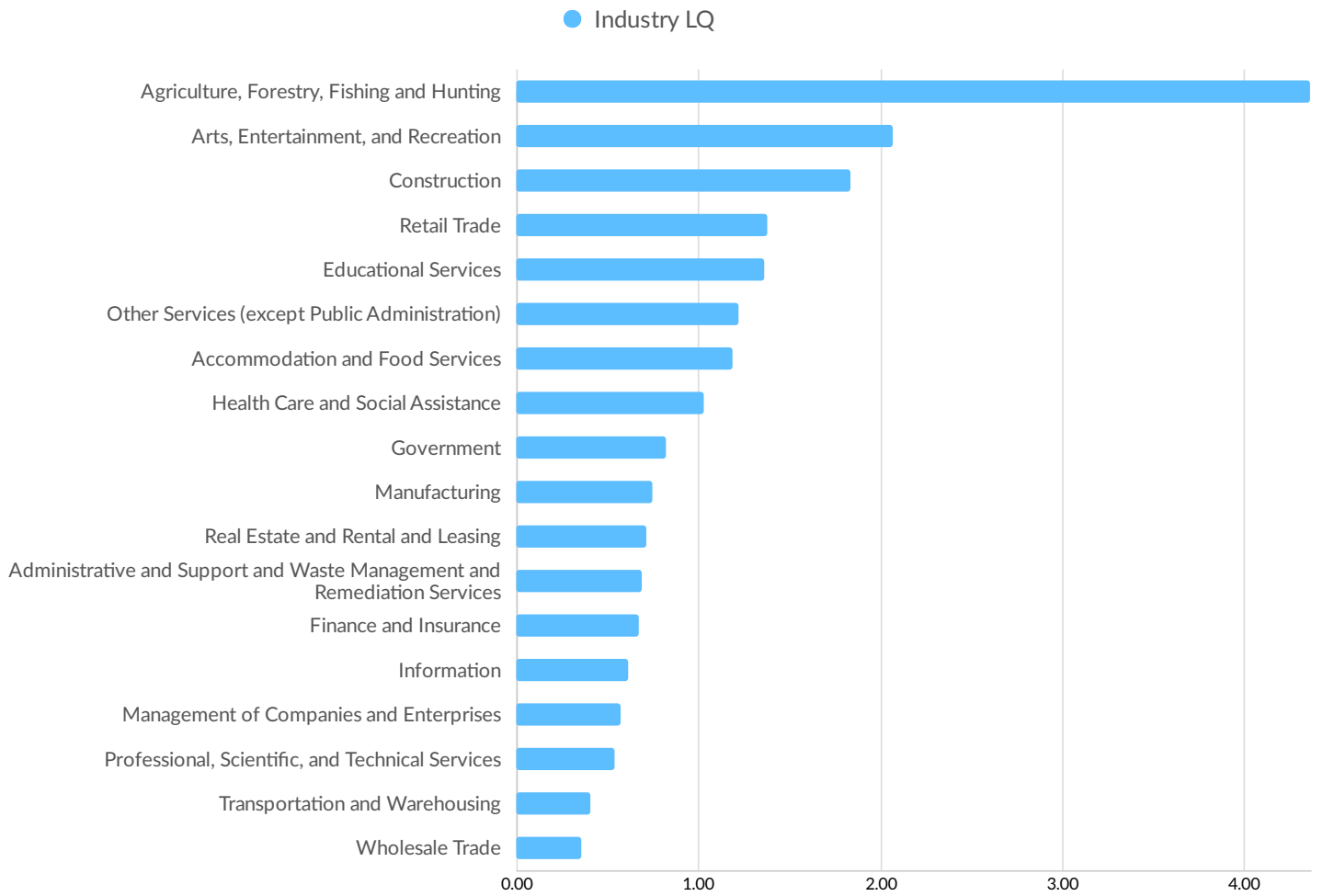

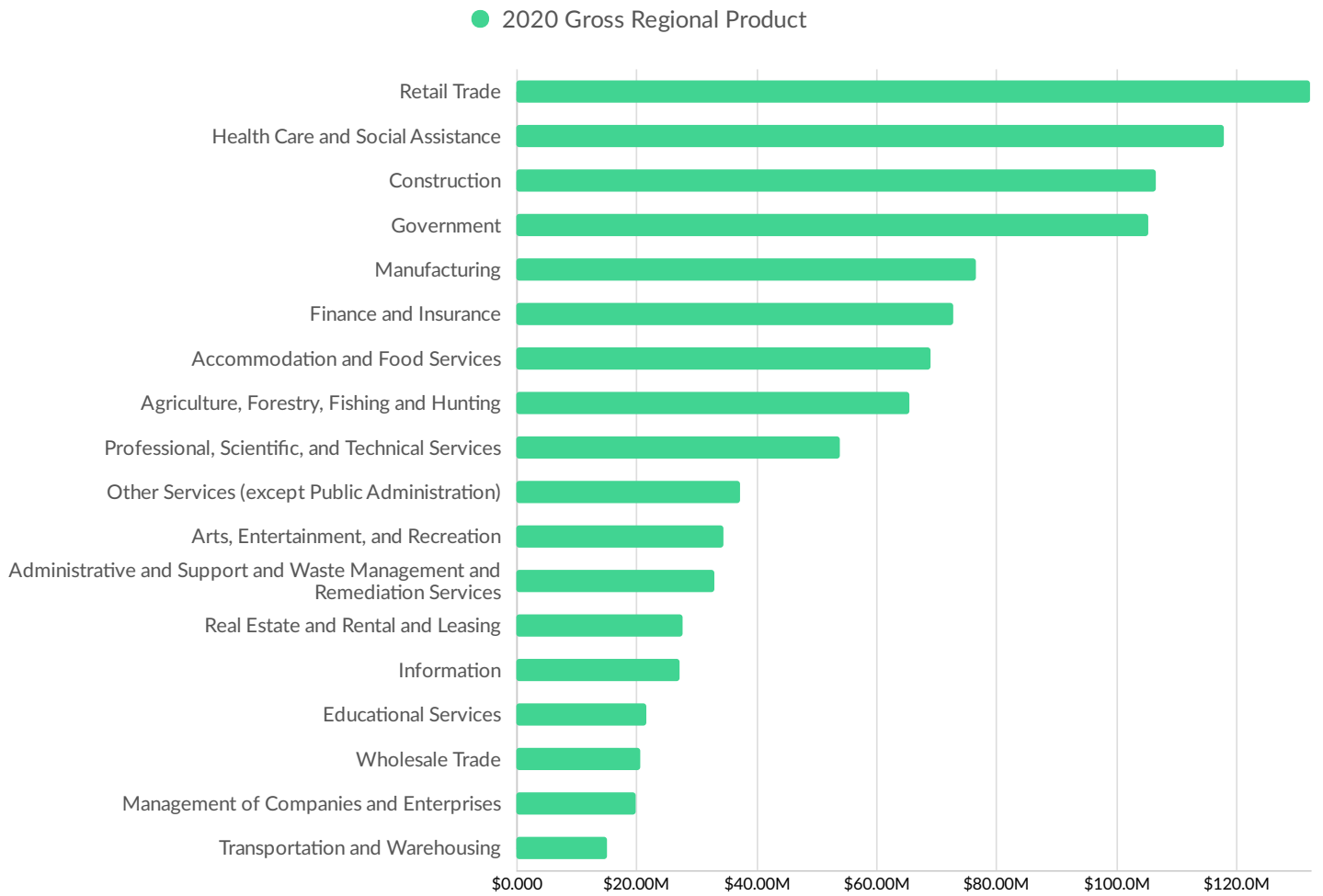
Top Growing Industries



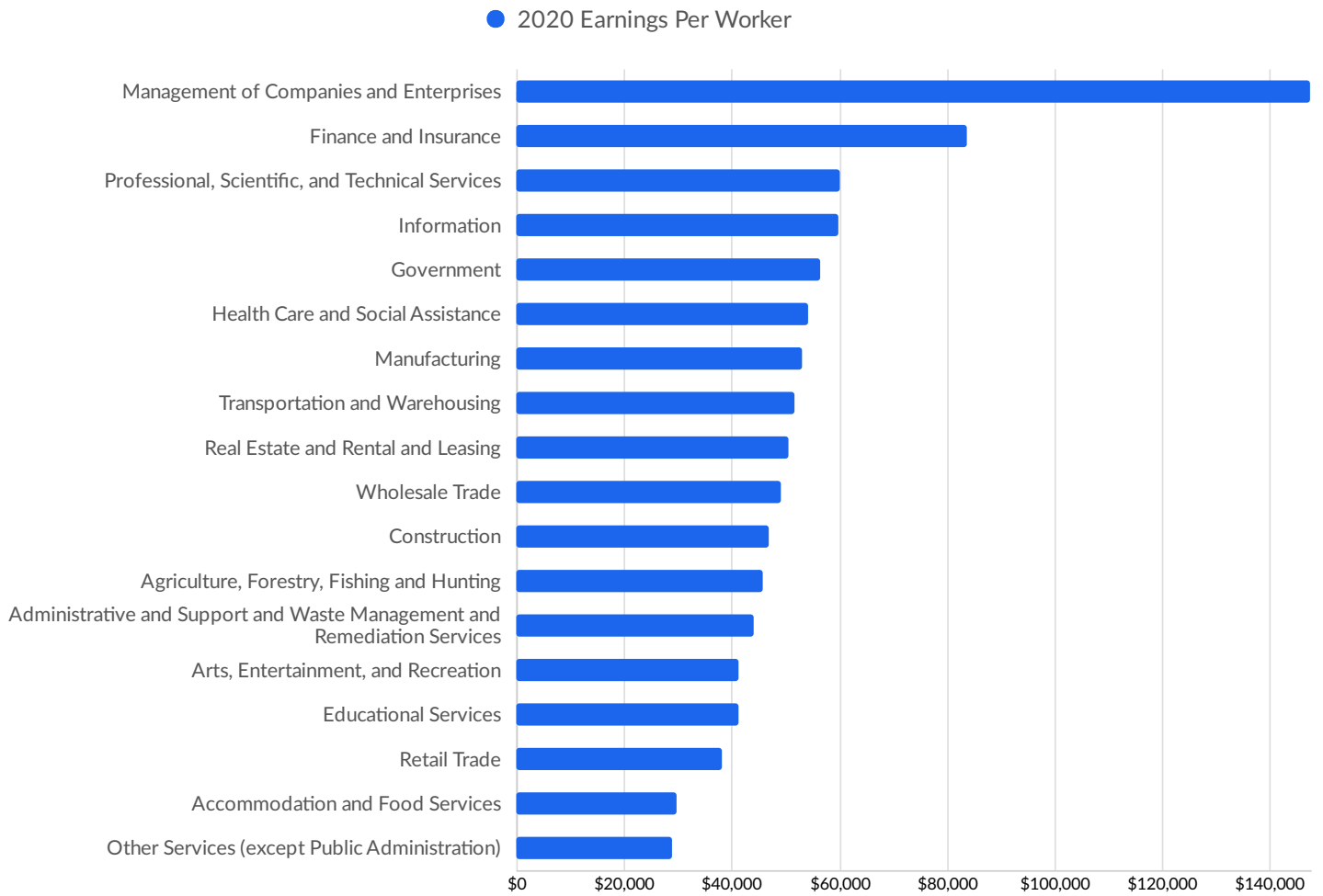
Top Industry LQ



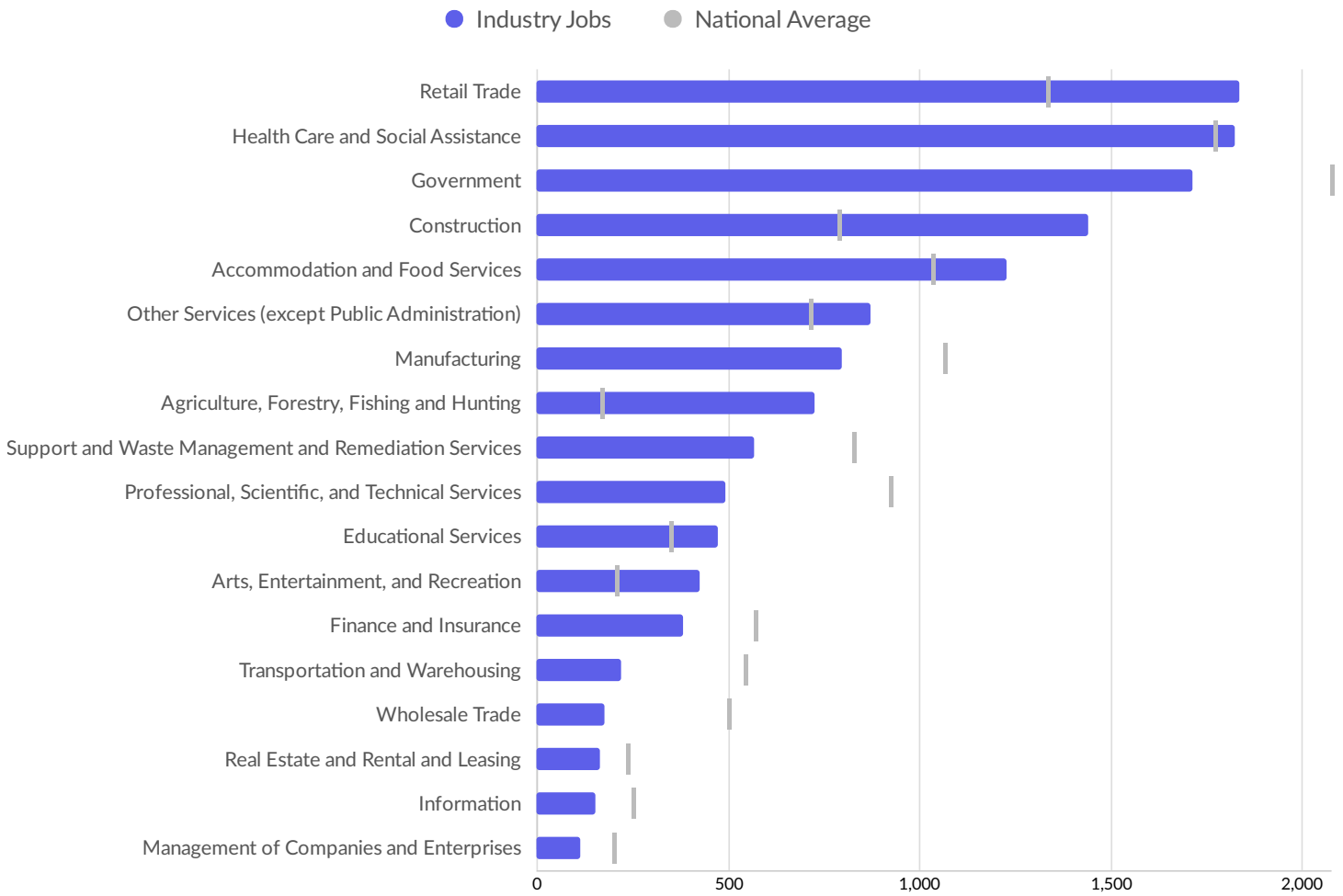

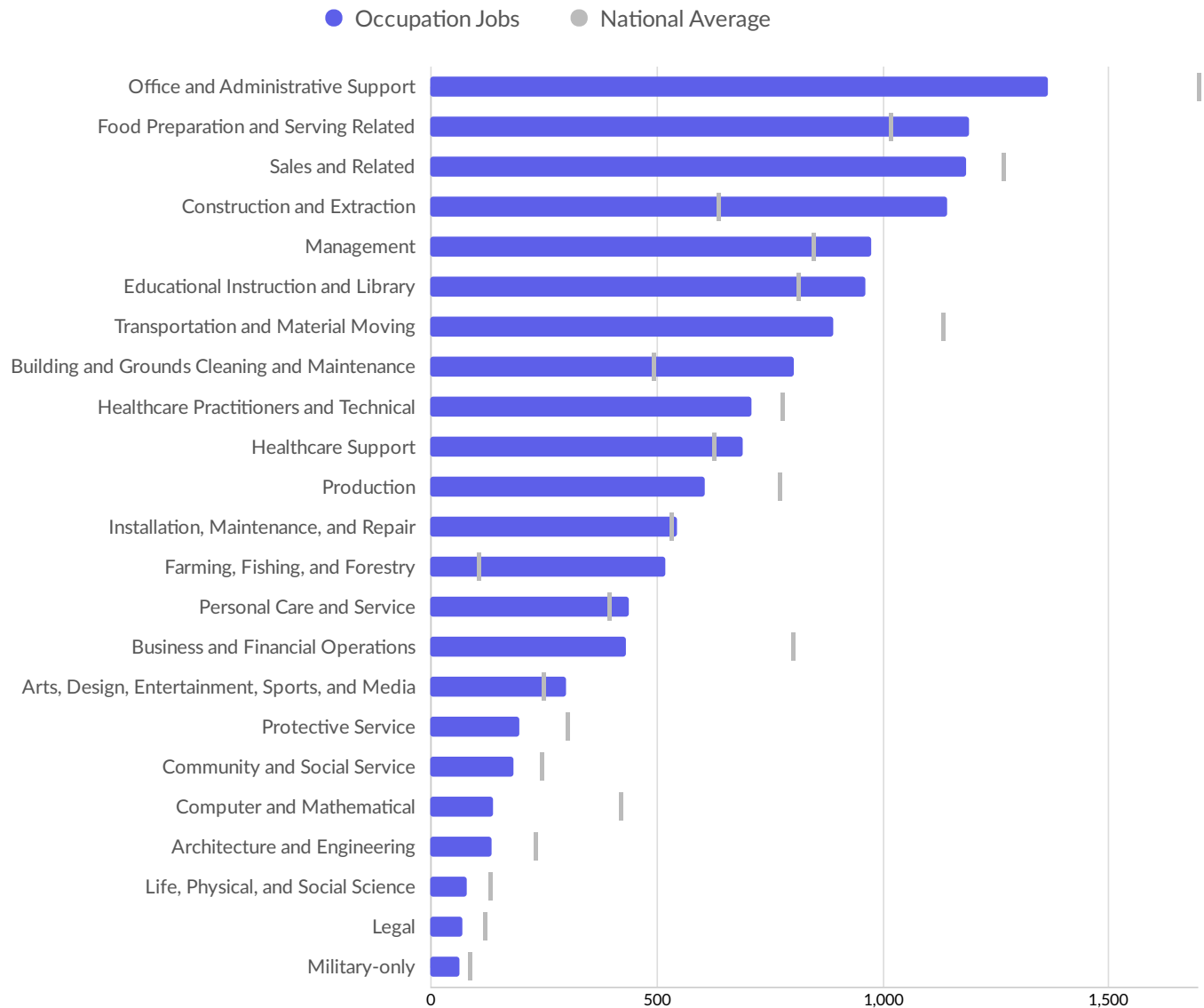

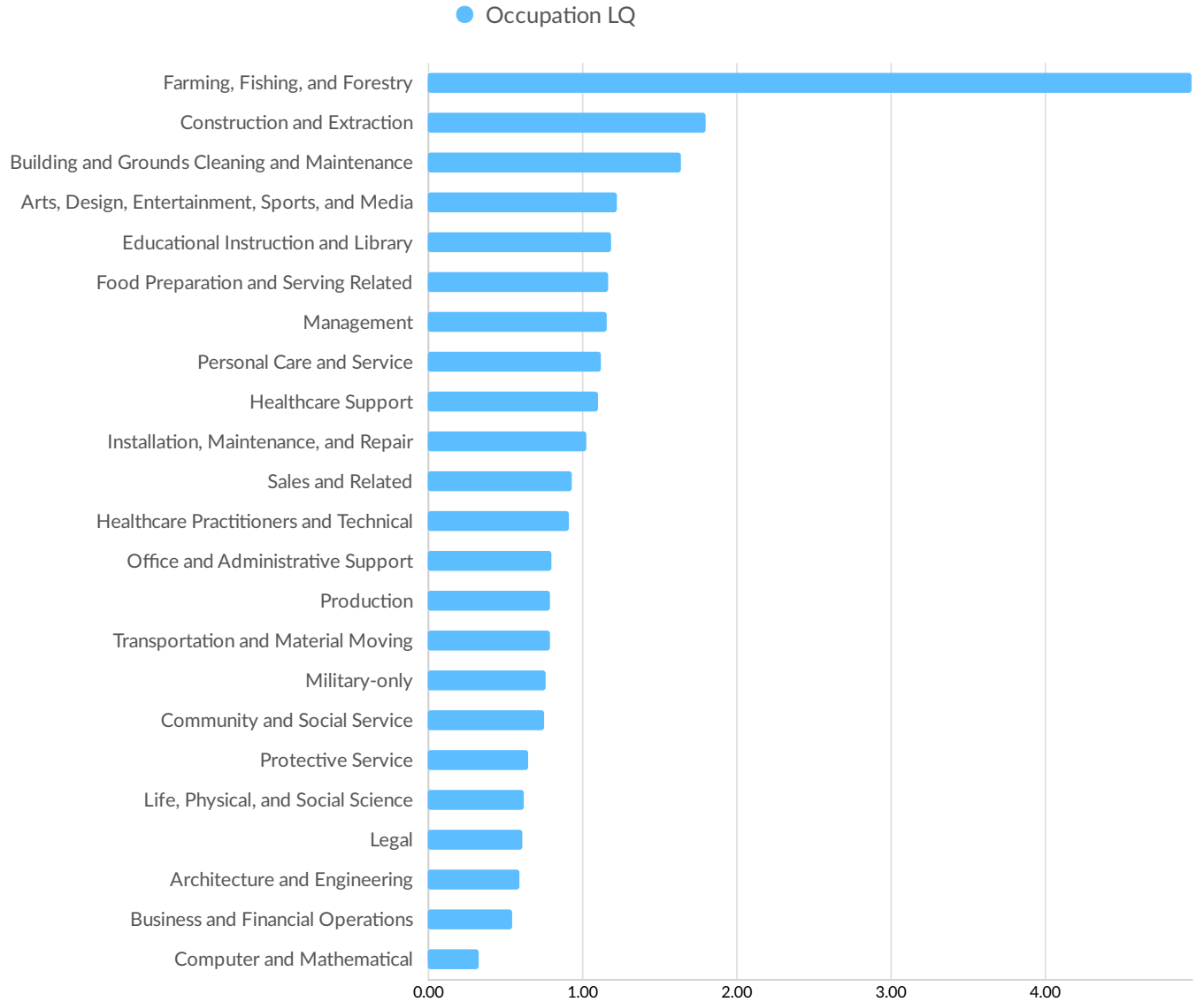

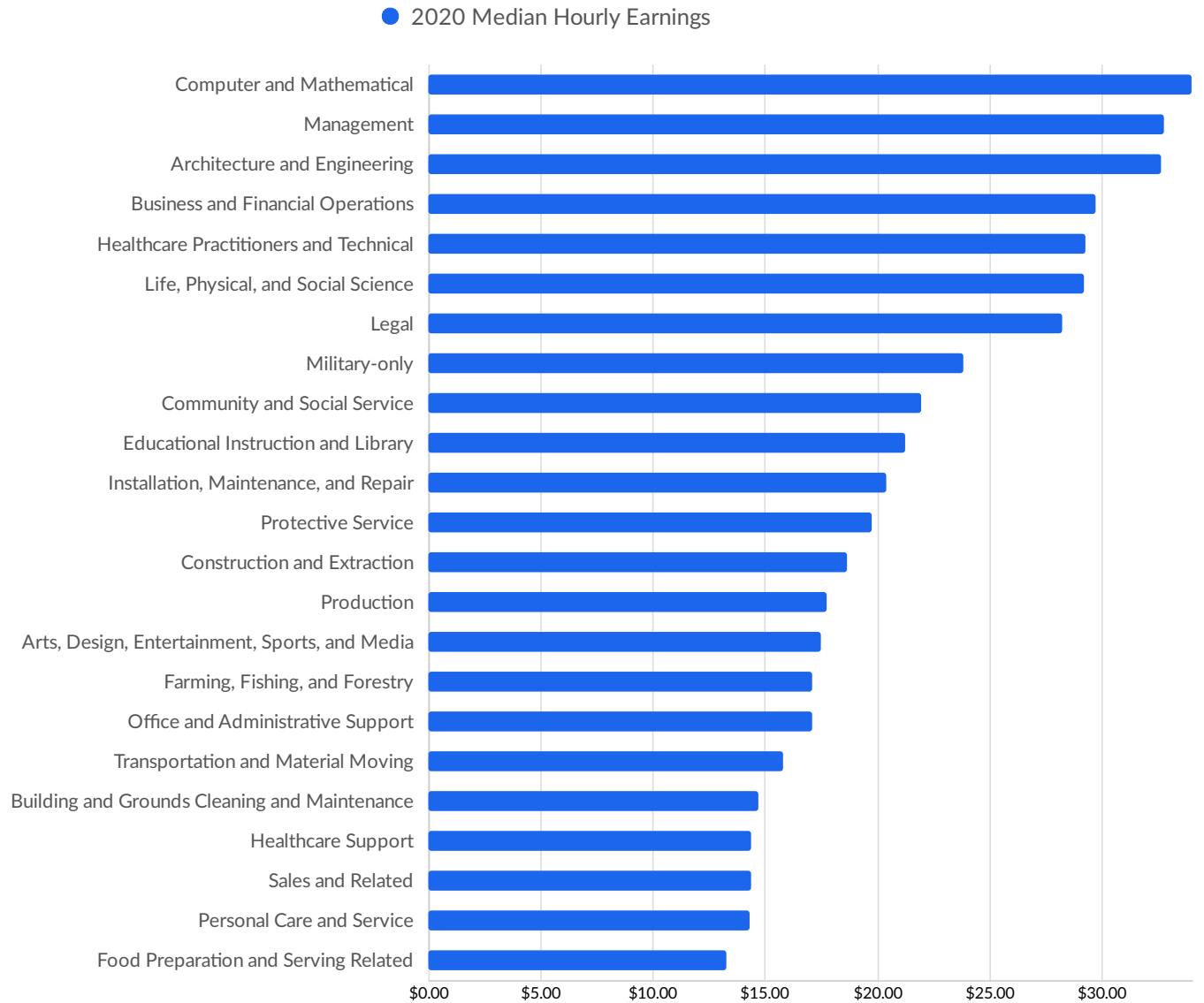
Top Growing Occupations



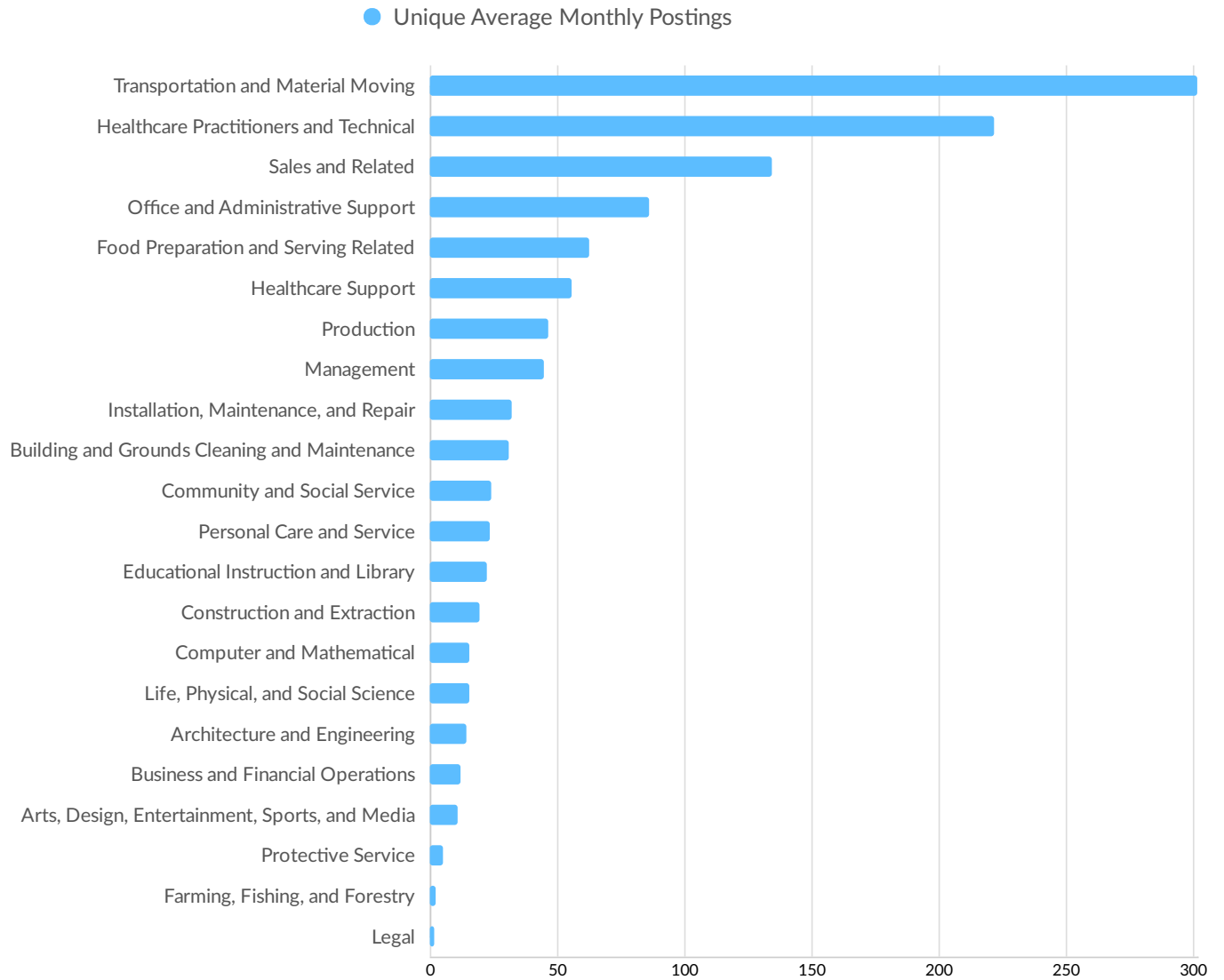
Top Occupation LQ



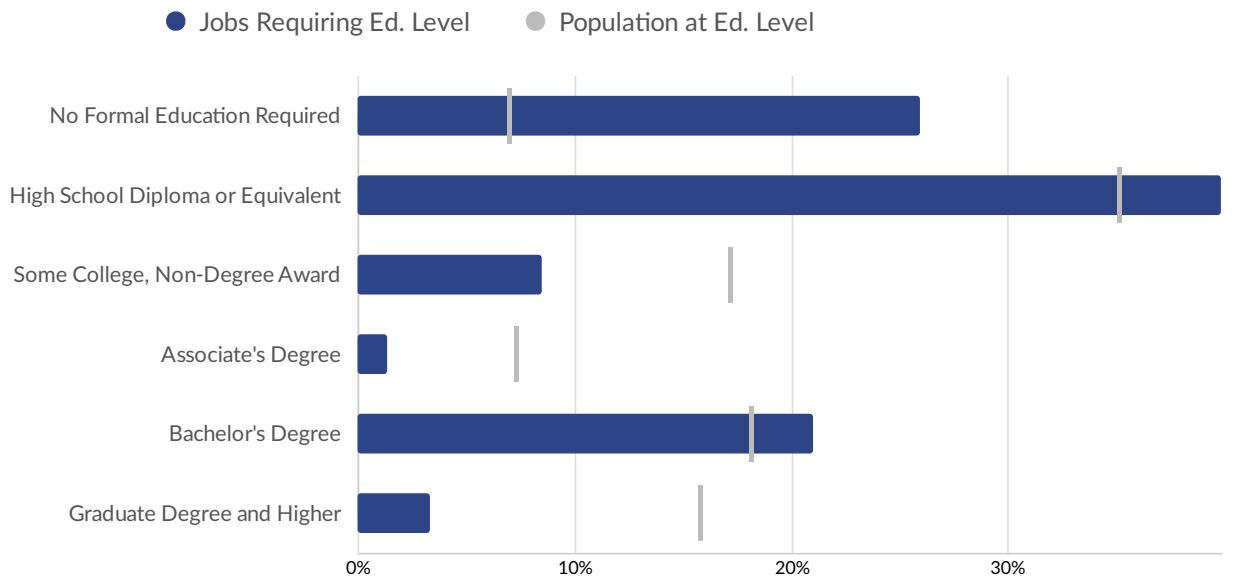
Top Occupation Earnings



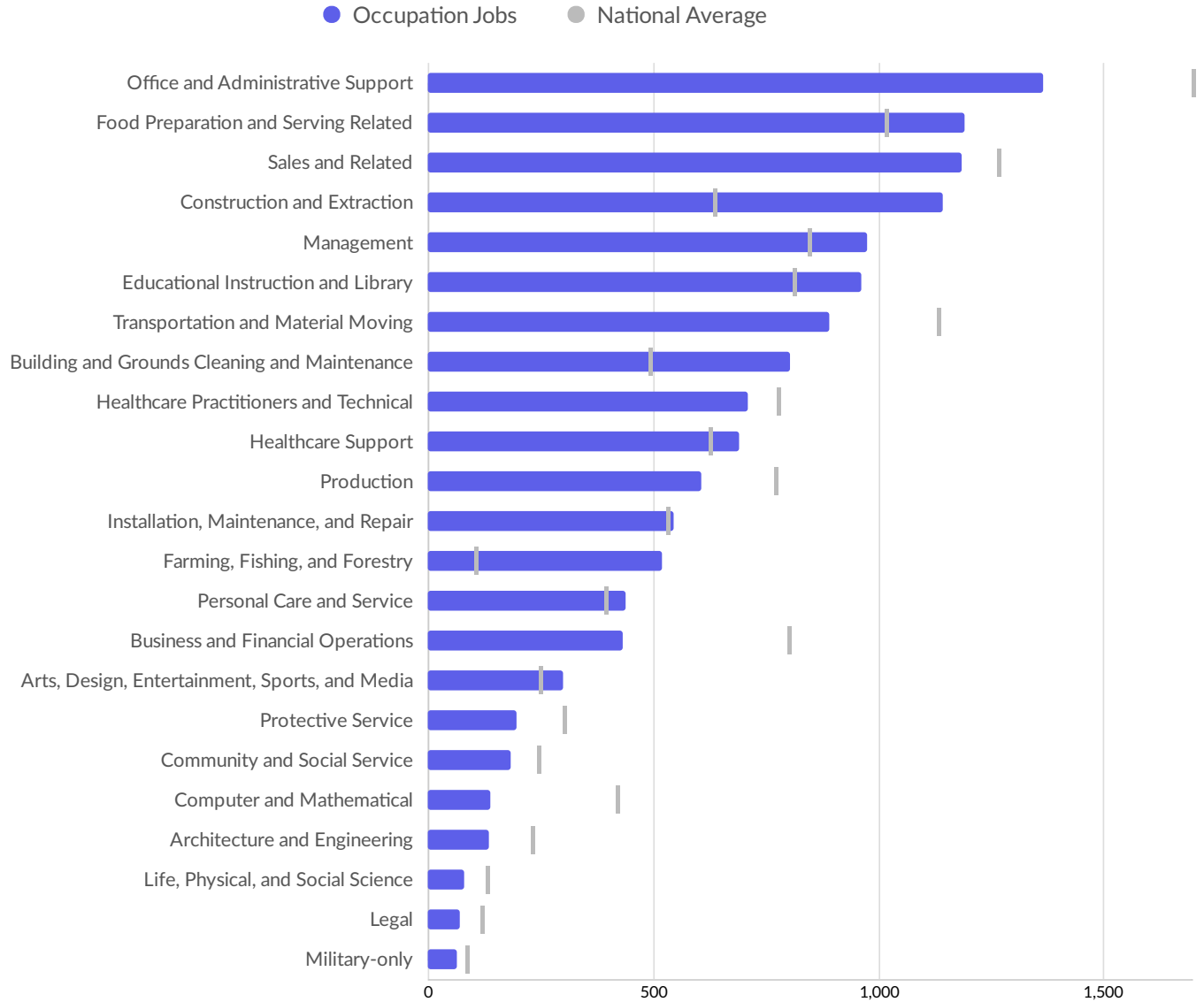
