Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 4.1% since 2015, growing by 8,302. Population is expected to increase by 3.7% between 2020 and 2025, adding 7,812.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 0.8% in York County, ME from 82,233 to 82,929. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 0.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 64.2% to 61.0% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **21.8% of York County**, **ME residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.7% above the national average), and **10.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Federal Government, Civilian, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).









Unemployment by Ethnicity








Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

York County, ME had a May 2021 unemployment rate of 4.57%, increasing from 3.37% 5 years before.






Millennials

York County, ME has 38,101 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 42,812.




York County, ME has 16,896

veterans. The national average for an area this size is 11.532.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in York County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 61,049 people 55 or older, while there are 77,517 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in York County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 82,825 racially diverse people, while there are 12,647 here.




Property Crime












2020 Median Hourly Earnings








