

Project Overview

In December 2021, Coastal Counties Workforce, Inc. was awarded \$380,308 in funding through the Maine Department of Labor via the U.S. Department of Labor to create a Virtual American Job Center.

This grant focuses on the research, development, and implementation of a multi-faceted Virtual American Job Center that will expand access to services for job seekers and employers most adversely affected by the Covid pandemic. Emphasis is on ensuring the platform includes the digital improvements necessary to reach Maine's most vulnerable populations by providing easy to navigate, customer-centric access to services. Digital improvements will be designed to intentionally expand reach to historically marginalized unemployed populations.
