The Maine Rural Healthcare Partnership (MRHP) is a four-year, \$2.5 million dollar **H-1B Job Training Grant** awarded to Coastal Counties Workforce, Inc. by the U.S. Department of Labor in January 2021.



FREE SERVICES PROVIDED:

- **One-on-one guidance:** A *Healthcare Career Advisor* will offer assessment and guidance on finding a healthcare training program that fits the individual's interests.
- **Training in healthcare careers:** Paid occupational training for enrollees, including the cost of required materials, uniforms, books, and tools.
- **Support services:** Healthcare Career Advisors address barriers to training and employment, including technology & internet access.
- **Support with virtual or hybrid training models:** Participants can receive support from staff in utilizing remote learning platforms.
- **Connection with employment:** Healthcare Career Advisors can assist with the process of applying for and acquiring employment, including job searching, resume writing.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Resident of one of the six Coastal Counties (York, Cumberland, Sagadahoc, Lincoln, Waldo, Knox)
- 17 years or older
- Authorized to work in the U.S.
- Not enrolled in high school
- Unemployed or underemployed
